Visitor Center - Contractor will Provide Supplies & Materials; Scrape and Paint Exterior; Paint Interior Back Room

Ball Field Dugouts & Press Box - Scrape and Paint Inside & Outside.
Will Take 8 People 6 hours

Polish Statue -Sculptor will wash and clean statue, apply wax, buff bronze, remove tarnish on rings

Repairs - Volunteers will replace siding on a portion of Home Replica;
will take 2 People 4 Hours

Power Wash - Volunteers will power wash fungus and stain from stonework at base of Jesse Owens Museum. Will Take 2 People 1 Day

Install Utility Fence - Volunteers will dig holes, set poles in concrete, and set fence panels and install the gate. Will take 2 people 1½ days.

Install Visitor Center Sign - Contractor will build and install a 4 by 6 foot metal sign which will include a 3-line message board with 4-inch letters.

Plantings

Landscaper will correct drainage problems at both the visitor center and museum. Five hundred twenty-eight feet of evergreen screen will be planted along main road and behind visitor's center to ball field. This will give a more pleasing appearance to the overall park by blocking out undesirable neighboring structures. Landscaping around visitor center will be in raised beds with steel edging. Five gutters will be piped out and beds mulched. The area around museum, torch replica and flagpoles will be landscaped using raised beds, steel edging and mulch. One hundred Vermont and Carolina colored trees will be planted along road, drive and properties to accentuate park features. Landscaping the 20-acre Jesse Owens Memorial Park will create a visitor friendly appearance while providing a more visually pleasing landscape year-around.
